## **Snow Days**

We frequently receive questions concerning the process for determining when a “Snow Day” will be declared. The process begins between 4:30 a.m. – 5:00 a.m. District officials communicate with the highway departments regarding road conditions. Available information concerning weather conditions is reviewed. A decision to close school must be made by 6:20 a.m., at the latest. That is the time that the school buses begin to leave.

We, typically, will not delay the opening of school, i.e. deciding to open after a one or two hour delay. That decision often results in childcare difficulties for parents, especially for parents who must report to work at their regularly-scheduled time. Also, given the unpredictability of the weather, better weather conditions that are predicted at 6:20 a.m., for later in the morning, may not actually develop. In that circumstance, a decision to close school, rather than delay, may be made. That situation may result in even greater concern and difficulty for parents. A delayed opening for weather conditions, therefore, is not typically used, but is certainly an option.

Please consider planning for possible “snow day” childcare needs now. It is always best to be prepared and ready ahead of time.
